DELINEATION OF CLINICAL PRIVILEGES
PEDIATRICS**

The following information is provided to the Active Staff (Attendings and Associates) so that they can meet the criteria set forth by the Department in order to retain their Active status. Yale-New Haven Hospital reappoints biennially during the birth month.

In accordance with the basic requirements of the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations and the professional standards of Yale-New Haven Hospital, the Department of Pediatrics has established minimal standards for appointment/reappointment to the Active Staff of the Hospital.

In addition to the criteria enumerated in The Bylaws of the Yale-New Haven Hospital, Inc. for the Medical Staff, all candidates for appointment/reappointment to the Active Staff must fulfill the following requirements:

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| Criteria: | 1. | A minimum of fifty (50) points per year (100 biennially) |
| | 2. | Some points need to be accrued from at least two different categories (I. Patient Care, II. Teaching/Education, III. Hospital/Dept. functions) |
| | 3. | If minimum points are not accrued each year, status reviewed by Chief/Associate Chief |
| | 4. | If no points are accrued from Category I (Patient Care) over one year, co-attending will be needed for admitted patients the following year. |
