DELINEATION OF CLINICAL PRIVILEGES
PSYCHIATRY**

The following information is provided to the Active Staff (Attendings and Associates) so that they can meet the criteria set forth by the Department in order to retain their Active status. Yale-New Haven Hospital reappoints biennially during the birth month.

In accordance with the basic requirements of the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations and the professional standards of Yale-New Haven Hospital, the Department of Psychiatry has established minimal standards for appointment/reappointment to the Active Staff of the Hospital.

In addition to the criteria enumerated in The Bylaws of the Yale-New Haven Hospital, Inc. for the Medical Staff, all candidates for appointment/reappointment to the Active Staff must fulfill the following requirements:

Criteria: A total of fifty (50) points per year of which at least ten (10) points must come from Section 4 below:

(1) Clinical Services* (Can be fulfilled in four ways, not to exceed 30 points/year)		
• Participate collaboratively in patient care for inpatient and partial hospital Services at YNHH	= 5 pts./year	_____
• Provide consultations on Consultation Service	= 2 pts./consult	_____
• Consult to Ambulatory Services	= 12.5 pts/hr/wk	_____
• Participate in medication hearing panels during the year	= 2 pts/hearing	_____
(2) Clinical Teaching**		
• Supervision of Yale psychiatry residents including the willingness to see Patients collaboratively with residents at YNHH, CMHC, UHSC, WHVA, and YPI	= 12.5 pts/hr/wk	_____
(3) Clinical Research at Yale-New Haven Hospital		
• Involvement in clinical research with a FT attending at YNHH	= 12.5 pts/hr/wk	_____

Combinations of involvement in clinical services, teaching and research are possible for Meeting criteria as an alternative to major involvement in just one area as long as at Least ten (10) points, but no more than thirty (30) points, come from item #4.

(4) Involvement in quality improvement ***		
• Critical incidents conferences/other clinical & quality improvement Conferences or CME category I & II activities (any AMA approved)	= 1 pt/hr	_____
• Participation in Advisory, Credentials, and other Committees of the Medical Board	= 10 pts/comte	_____
• Attendance at Department Grand Rounds and other YNHH conferences	= 2 pts/hr	_____

*Equivalent clinical involvement at YPI will count toward satisfaction of these criteria

**If clinical involvement takes place at YPI or if teaching occurs at YPI, CMHC, WHVA, or UHSC, a letter from the Medical Director of the institution is required testifying to the quality of clinical work, teaching, and participation in QI activities and commenting upon whether there have been any problems based on direct observation.

***Psychiatry will provide a sign-in list at all Grand Rounds. The Department will try to schedule conferences at early morning and late afternoon times to facilitate participation by the Active Staff. Involvement in quality improvement and medical staff tasks alone will not fulfill criteria; these activities must be combined with criteria #1 - #3.

***You must also demonstrate involvement in teaching/administrative activities at YNH in order to fulfill the requirements of the YNH-CMG.**
